- Celebrated '*World Earth Day*' on 22.4.2021 and planted 200 fodder and medicinal plants with active collaborations of the employee.
- Celebrated '*World Veterinary Day*' on 24.4.2021 and organised a virtual meeting of Veterinarians/Scientists on the topic 'Importance of Vaccination' with two eminent key-note speakers Prof (Col) A.K. Gahlot (Former VC, RAJUVAS, Bikaner) and Prof. M.P. Yadav (Former Director IVRI, Izatnagar & VC, SVPUAT, Meerut).
- Looking at the demand of camel milk, milk and milk products are being sold at the milk parlour. A total of 126 packets of pasteurized camel milk (250 ml capacity) and 186 litres raw camel milk were sold for human health use.
